



Jose Gómez Rial graduated in Biological Sciences at the University of Santiago in 1999, two years later obtained the Diploma for Advanced Studies in Molecular Biology and Biochemistry. He obtained his specialization in Immunology in 2007 at the Hospital Ramon y Cajal (Madrid), where he has worked as Immunologist until 2008, when he joined to the Hospital Universitario Santiago de Compostela to drive the Histocompatibility Unit in the Immunology

Laboratory. In 2011, under his direction, the laboratory achieved ENAC accreditation (UNE EN ISO:15189) and becomes the first Immunology Laboratory in Spain to get this merit. From 2012, he is the director of the European Federation for Immunogenetics (EFI) program in the Hospital Universitario Santiago de Compostela, responsible for the searchings of unrelated bone marrow donors worldwide.
